

# Privacy Policy/Personal Data Protection Act

## We Respect and Keep Your Data Safe

The Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA) protects your personal data while enabling organisations to use your data reasonably to serve you.

Halogen Foundation Singapore, as a non-profit organisation dedicated to developing and realising the leadership and entrepreneurship potential of Singapore's youth, respect and keep your data safe by:

- limiting access to persons who are involved in the conduct of our programmes and events,
- conducting regular checks to ensure that your personal data is only accessed by authorised persons, and
- removing details, as far as possible, that identify you when using your data for internal purposes.

## Serving You as a Non-Profit Organisation

When you participate in any of Halogen Foundation Singapore's activities, we may use your personal data to invite you to participate in future programmes, shortlist you for participation in relevant research studies or for promotional activities and fundraising to further the work of Halogen Foundation.

As a non-profit organisation, we may also share relevant data and participate in national and multi-agency efforts to:

- review educational curriculum for youth in Singapore,
- conduct research to improve the quality of leadership and entrepreneurial programmes for youth in Singapore,
- train future generations of youth leaders in Singapore.

Please be assured that if your personal data is collected, used or disclosed for these purposes, we will protect it as required under the PDPA and other relevant legislation.
