**Advisory and Precautionary Measures
in view of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak**

We have been following the ongoing developments of the COVID-19 outbreak and have noted on the additional precautionary measures by the Singapore Government to minimise the spread of the virus issued progressively.

As an organisation that has substantial interface with students, teachers and volunteers, we will be taking the following precautionary measures in line with the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of Health, and the National Council of Social Services:

- All persons involved in programmes with Halogen Foundation will be required to take and record their temperature, and declare their travel and contact history
- All visitors to our premises will be required to take and record their temperature, and declare their travel and contact history
- All persons who have travelled to countries listed in the Singapore Government's travel advisory and under the border restrictions within the past 14 days will not be permitted into our programmes and premises
- All persons who are unwell (exhibit a fever, cough, or breathing difficulties) will not be permitted into our programmes and premises

Good hygiene practices are our best defence against infectious diseases and we urge everyone to practice good hygiene whenever possible. We also urge those who are feeling unwell to seek medical attention immediately and to minimise any form of social contact.
